



Holy Comforter's operating deficit (offering expenses in excess of income during April was \$1,401.85. Total giving to support Holy Comforter's routine expenses for the month was \$23,867.37. The budget estimate of the amount needed each month in 2024 is \$30,278.50. The year-to-date surplus, through April 30, was \$3,453.31. Year to date spending was \$14,741.79 below the amount planned in the 2024 budget. The foregoing table provides additional perspective and comparisons with offering income, expenses and budgets in prior years.
